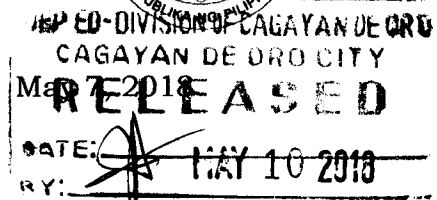

**2-DAY LIVE-OUT OPEN HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM/ADM IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW
AND TRAINING WORKSHOP**

1. Pursuant to RA 10665 or the Open High School System Act and RA 9155 or Basic Education Governance Act and the constitutional mandate on provision of alternative delivery and access to basic education, there will be a 2-day Live-out Open High School Program (OHSP)-ADM Implementation Review and Training Workshop for school heads/principals and school OHSP Coordinators/select OHSP Teachers of OHSP Implementing Schools on June 1-2, 2018, 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., the venue to be announced (TBA) in next issuance.
2. This activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Discuss the recent updates on ADM/OHSP policies and developments ;
 - b. Identify ways to make OHSP Implementation more effective in alternative delivery;
 - c. Discuss Drop-out Reduction Program (DORP) issues and concerns, strategies to pro-actively reduced drop-outs, and preparations for access and prevention/mitigation of Learners at Risk of Repeating and Failing (LARF) and Learners at Risk of Dropping-out (LARDO's);
 - d. Review and discuss issues and concerns to enhanced OHSP implementation, monitoring, ownership of communities and stakeholders support;
 - e. Present status of implementation, achievements and best practices ;
 - f. Prepare/present class program for SY 2018-2019; and
 - g. Strengthen OHSP advocacy.
3. All participating schools/coordinators must bring with them the data or performance indicators, such as OHSP enrollment, number of promoted or learners who graduated from the program from the start of the school's OHSP Implementation to the recent SY 2017-2018 data, and other pertinent records. A power point presentation with a maximum of 8 slides for best practices and relevant achievement shall be prepared by implementing schools;
4. Service credits will be granted to teacher participants and working committees, while a Compensatory Time -Off (CTO) will be provided to non-teaching personnel involved, subject to existing laws and policy:
5. Food, accommodation, supplies and materials shall be charged to Division/local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
