



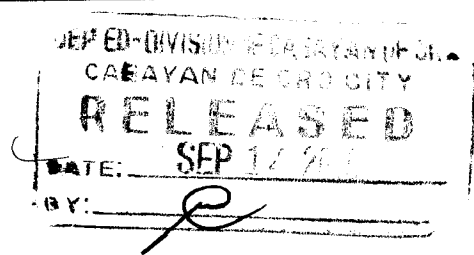

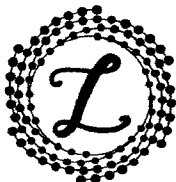

**POSTER MAKING CONTEST IN CELEBRATION OF THE
FISH CONSERVATION WEEK 2018**

1. Eligibility – The poster making contest is open to high school students (grade 7-10) currently enrolled in any public and private schools in Cagayan de Oro City.
2. Theme – Entries must interpret the theme: *“Kapag Karagatan ng Munisipal ay Inalagaan, Sasagana ang Yamang-dagat ng Buong Sambayanan”*.
3. Number of participants – A total of 15 slots will be available for the contest.
4. Poster Making – The rules of the poster making are as follows:
 - a. The entry must be done on a ¼ illustration board (20 inches x 15 inches) and must be in portrait orientation.
 - b. Materials provided for the poster making contest are the following:
 - * ¼ illustration board, 1 box oil paster (16 colors), 1 white board marker, pencil (#2), 1 rubber eraser, 1 pack cotton balls
 - c. The contest will begin at 9:00 AM and will end at 2:00 PM
5. Judging - Entries will be judged anonymously by a panel of judges selected by BFAR-10. The names of the artists will not be disclosed to the judges until the winners have been officially determined. The posters will be judged based on the following indicators:
 - Relevance to the theme – 40% (demonstrates awareness and understanding of the theme; critical and in-depth application of the theme)
 - Creativity and Presentation – 30% (unique approach to the theme, both in terms of its artistic rendition and insight)
 - Originality – 30% (not lifted from other sources)

The decision of the panel of judges shall be final and not subject to appeal.

6. Prizes – The following are the prizes for each category:

1 st Prize	P3,000.00
2 nd Prize	P2,000.00
3 rd Prize	P1,000.00
(with certificate of award)
